**NIYAH (Intention) FOR FASTING** in Ramadan must be made simply in one's heart before Fajr either once for the whole month of Ramadan or once everyday. It was not the practice of the Prophet (PBUH) to recite words out loud in declaring intention to fast.

**DU'AA (Supplication) AT THE TIME OF BREAKING THE FAST (Iftar)**

- Before Iftar, make any Du'aa asking for Allah's forgiveness and mercy, such as:  
 "Allahumma inni as`alooka bi rahmatika allattee wasi'at kulla shai` an taghfir-lee."  
 "O Allah, I ask you, by Your mercy that encompasses all things, that You forgive me."
- Then, at the time of Iftar, say:  
 "Bismillah. Dhaba ath-zama` wabtallatil 'urooq wathabatal `ajru, Insha` Allah."  
 "In the name of Allah, The thirst has gone, the veins are quenched, and the reward is confirmed by the will of Allah."
